How to find Oxstalls Indoor Tennis Centre

From M5 Junction 11
Take slip road signpost Gloucester (A40). At roundabout take the fourth exit RIGHT towards Ross and the Forest of Dean (A40).

At the end of the dual carriageway, past the Audi garage on your left, TURN LEFT towards Gloucester City Centre.

Travel about 200 yards, past the Longford Inn BeeFeater pub on your right, and TURN LEFT (opposite Winfield hospital) into PLOCK COURT. Travel 20 yards and you will see a signpost for Oxstalls Indoor Tennis Centre. Travel along access road and you will see the Indoor Centre in front of you.

From Cheltenham

Travel along the Golden Valley By-pass (A40) towards Gloucester City and at roundabout TURN RIGHT (fourth exit) towards Forest of Dean and Ross (A40) and follow the directions as above from point 2.

From Stroud - follow directions as M5

From Forest of Dean

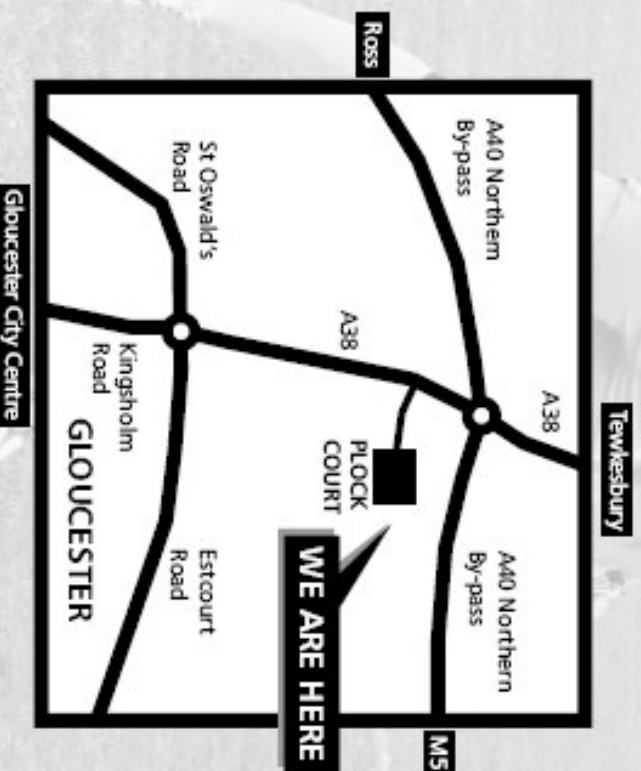
Take the A40 into Gloucester. At the Over roundabout go STRAIGHT ON towards Cheltenham. At the next roundabout TURN RIGHT towards Gloucester City Centre. And follow the direction above from point 3.

From Tewkesbury

Travel along the A38 from Tewkesbury to Gloucester City. At the Longford roundabout go STRAIGHT ON towards Gloucester City Centre. And follow the direction above from point 3.

From Cirencester

Travel along the A417 towards Gloucester & Cheltenham. At the Air balloon pub on the left TURN LEFT towards Gloucester. On dual carriageway, at the bottom of the hill, take the turning M5 NORTH - WEST MIDLANDS and then follow directions from M5 Junction 11 as above

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY NEW VENUE, NEW RULES

Gloucester City Sports Development and Oxstalls Indoor Tennis Centre would like to welcome you to this year's festival.

This year's festival is situated on Gloucester's premier site for dry side sport and physical activity; however it is also surrounded by residential housing and although the centre holds numerous events during the year and residents are kept informed, considerations do need to be made for the sustainability of this festival for the future. With this in mind we need to make you aware of those conditions that must be upheld.

The campsite is on the adjacent school field, access from the tennis centre, for health & safety reasons, **NO CARS WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARK ON THE CAMPSITE NEXT TO YOUR TENTS, YOU WILL BE ABLE TO DRIVE TO THE CAMPSITE AND PICK UP, BUT ALL VEHICLES MUST LEAVE THE CAMPSITE AREA.** Failure to adhere to these conditions will result in eviction from the site.

- * The campsite will be marked out, campers are asked to stay within this area
- * Do not walk around the school site
- * Litter bins will be provided, please use them
- * Access to the tennis centre changing rooms, showers and toilets are available 24hrs, please keep clean and tidy
- * Competitors with large motor homes to park up in the tennis centre car park and not in the campsite
- * Campers are asked not to light open fires, small barbecues can be used providing common sense and safety considerations are met, **PLEASE KEEP DISPOSABLE BARBECUES OFF THE GROUND** [breakfasts, lunches and a barbecue will be available throughout the weekend]
- * All campers are asked to keep noise to a minimum, there will be security officers to ensure our 'neighbourhood' are kept happy
- * Please keep dogs on leads in the campsite area, doggy bins available. The large playing area 'Ploek Court' is used by locals for dog walking
